

THE TREEHOUSE LOTTERY RULES

PURPOSE:

The purpose of The Treehouse Lottery is to raise funds. The money will be paid into an allocated bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES:

- For £5 per month you will be allocated one number;
- A draw will be made on the last Friday of each month;
- The monthly prize will be a minimum of £200 a month;
- There will be a minimum prize review every three months, all lottery members will be notified if a change is to be made with a month's notice;
- The Treehouse Lottery is licensed and open to all parents, carers, staff, friends and supporters of The Treehouse School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join;
- Payments must be made by standing order monthly. One month's notice is required for cancellation;
- Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date;
- If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number will be withdrawn and sold to someone else;
- The draw shall be made at The Treehouse on the last Friday of each month, using a random number generator.
- The winnings will be paid by BACS within one week of the draw; or by cheque if requested.
- The name (if permitted) and number of each month's winner will be put in the Mini Update and shared on the school website;
- The Treehouse Lottery will be run by the PTA, in case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final;
- Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the lottery if his/her subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month;
- If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
- If in the event The Treehouse Lottery was to cease running in its entirety, all members will be given one month's written notice.
- It is the responsibility of the member to ensure The Treehouse Lottery has the most up to date contact details.
